In turn, it has helped to place us on the map and now we attract international improv comedy performers and students - all whom have traveled great distances to share in the excitement of the festival and its beautiful host city, Cape Town.

From 31 October to 04 November, improvisers from all over the globe will come to Cape Town to perform, teach and take classes.

Born out of a 2016 collaboration between South African-based improviser Eva Gilliam and Canadian improviser Ashley Commeau, this festival is the first of its kind to bring – en masse – international improv comedy performers and teachers to the tip of Africa, to mix and mingle and indulge in this hilarious, creative, inclusive art form.

The last two years have seen audiences grow by 100%, with performers from as far afield as USA, Canada, Norway, Denmark, the UK and all over South Africa.

About MamaCityIF



The Venue

This year MamaCityIF is happy to announce that we will be based at the Magnet Theatre in Observatory. The Magnet Theatre is one of Cape Town's gems: they strive to be a moving force in the lives and minds of people, wholeheartedly committed to community and the important role of theatre in shifting the current paradigm, locally and globally. PERFECT for improv comedy, where the sparks that ignite paradigm shifts are set off and new realities are foreshadowed.

Event Highlights

It's live, it's unscripted, it's mind-blowing. Is that enough of a highlight?

HEADLINE ACT: The Lusty Mannequins

Everyone's a "Canadian!"

Ashley Comeau, Alastair Forbes, Karen Parker, and Connor Thompson are the Lusty Mannequins. A Toronto, Canada-based improv troupe extraordinaire.

Each an alumni of the Second City Mainstage (one of the biggest feathers out there to put in an improv comedy cap!), combined they boast over 50 years of comedy experience.

Combined they would also weigh several hundred pounds and stand over twenty feet tall (if you were stacking them one on top of the other). Combined (again!) they have been nominated for Canadian Comedy Awards (with 3 wins for Karen Parker!), Canadian Screen Awards and Dora Awards and have performed with everyone from John Classe to the Kids in the Hall

Formed in 2008 by Ashley and Connor, the troupe got even lustier in 2016 with the addition of Alastair and Karen. These days they star in TV, write TV, produce TV, direct theatre, act in theatre, and teach and perform improv around the world.


